



**PÈRE LOUIS, AN EXCELLENT DWARF MANGO**

(*Mangifera indica* L.; see S. P. I. No. 51605)

In those parts of Florida where mango trees are likely to be injured by frosts, dwarf varieties admitting of relatively easy protection are particularly desirable. Three which have been introduced by the Office of Foreign Seed and Plant Introduction from the West Indies combine this characteristic with good quality of fruit. They are Père Louis, Julie, and D'Or. The fruit of Père Louis, illustrated above, weighs 6 to 8 ounces; it is greenish yellow, almost fiberless, and of rich, pleasant flavor.
