



JULIE, A DWARF MANGO FROM THE WEST INDIES

(*Mangifera indica* L.; S. P. I. No. 26125)

Like Père Louis and D'Or, Julie is a variety which has been distributed from the French West Indies throughout other islands of the Antilles and brought from Trinidad to the United States. All these varieties have proved valuable in Florida, where they bear more regularly than many of the East Indian sorts and where their dwarf growth renders them easily protected during frosty weather. Julie is a medium-sized flattened fruit, weighing about 6 ounces. The surface is rose colored to yellow, and the orange flesh is free from fiber, juicy, and of rich flavor.
