An orchard of Chinese Haw trees near Tai an fu, Shan-tung province, China. Trees of the Chinese haw which were grown from seeds sent in in 1906 by Mr. Frank N. Meyer are now growing in various localities in this country. As yet none of the imported varieties have fruited. The fact that good sized haw orchards are planted in China should encourage American horticulturists to study our own haw species and find out if they or the Chinese species are not worthy of orchard cultivation in this country.
