New Business

A) Election of officers

Pea CGC officers remain the same – Rebecca McGee, Chair; Kevin McPhee, Secretary Cool Season Legume CGC officers were elected as nominated:

Chair – Lyndon Porter Secretary – Julie Pasche

Weidong moved to accept the nominations and Bunyamin Taran seconded. Motion passed.

B) Evaluation projects

- a. Lyndon Porter reported on the BLRV project; 36 lines in the Pisum core collection were evaluated. BLRV inoculum was lost and he is actively looking for it in host plants across the landscape. 36 commercial lines were screened and he is working with a mapping population with Rebecca.
- b. Weidong Chen reported on powdery mildew screening. GH evaluations resulted in screening against *Erysiphe trifolii*. Jim Myers screened the germplasm in the field against *Erysiphe pisi* and found little complete resistance. KASP markers are available for *er-1*.
- c. Rebecca reported on changes to the evaluation proposal application procedures. 1) Funding levels have been changed to \$20-35,000 for 2 year projects, 2) Selection is based on the crop vulnerability statements. It was mentioned that the vulnerability statements for both CGCs needs to be updated. Kevin and Rebecca will lead the revision of the Pea vulnerability statements, Clare and Rebecca will lead the revision of the Cool Season Legume vulnerability statements. Lyndon commented that a statement on needs for pea was developed at the Bozeman meeting in Fall of 2016.

C) Plant Explorations

Clare Coyne reported on the planned exploration for lentil in Spain. Details and exchange guidelines are being worked out and the collection is expected to happen in 2018 or 2019.

D) Clare presented the curators report – new wild chickpea from Turkey collected by Eric Bishop von Wettberg and donated by UCD Doug Cook are now in the collection. A new collection of *Pisum fulvum* has been donated to WSU. As seed becomes available and permissions given, they will be added to the USDA germplasm collection.
