Unless otherwise stated, material was received as seeds and was collected in the Dutch East Indies.

139336. *ACANTHUS* sp. Acanthaceae.

No. 303. From low, sandy places on the island of Boeroe, Moluccas, May 2, 1940. A plant 2 to 3 feet high, with dark-green, almost spineless leaves, spikes of white flowers, and brownish-orange fruits.

139337. *AEGICERAS CORNICULATUM* (L.) Blanco. Myrsinaceae.

No. 310. From the island of Boeroe, May 3, 1940. A swamp shrub, with fragrant white flowers borne in clusters.

139338. *ALBIZZIA* sp. Mimosaceae.

No. 299. From Tomahoe Island, Moluccas, May 1, 1940.

139339 to 139341. *ALPINIA* spp. Zingiberaceae.139339. *ALPINIA* sp.

No. 306. From Mount Tomahoe, island of Boeroe, May 2, 1940. A species with lanceolate, dark-green leaves more than 1 foot long and scarlet fruits in bunches 1 foot long.
