

150715. LITCHI PHILIPPINENSIS Radlk. Sapindaceae.**Philippine lychee.**

From Honduras. Seeds presented by V. E. Scott, Tela Railroad Co., Tegucigalpa. Received April 6, 1945.

A Philippine relative of the lychee (*Litchi chinensis*). The tree is about 50 feet high, with dark-green pinnate leaves similar to those of the lychee, and roundish oblong fruits about an inch long borne in loose terminal clusters. The tough leathery shell encloses scanty edible pulp in which is embedded a relatively large seed. This seed is roasted and eaten. The tree may have value as a stock for the lychee (*L. chinensis*).
