161726. No. 14340. Edge of fir-pine forest, upper slopes of Volcan de Nevada, near El Isote, Jalisco. Dec. 18, 1947. (Tubers.)

161727. No. 14342. In thicket on edge of field, near Sayula, slopes of Volcan de Nevada, Jalisco. Plants large; tubers white or tinged with purple. Dec. 18, 1947. (Tubers.)

161728. *SOLANUM POLYADENIUM* Greenm.**Nightshade.**

No. 14374. Old lava flow, near Matujeo, Michoacán. Tubers white or with reddish-purple tinge; fruits green with prominent deep-green stripes. Dec. 13, 1947. (Seeds.)

No. 14378. Pine-fir forest near San José de las Cumbres, Michoacán. Fruits pale-green. Dec. 24, 1947. (Tubers.)

No. 14410. Pine-oak forest on summit of mountains north of Chilpancingo, Guerrero. Fruits ellipsoid-ovoid, deep-green, and shiny, up to 3 cm. long. Dec. 27, 1947. (Seeds.)
