No. 199. Cultivated, Lorenzo R. Parodi Grass Garden. Feb. 6. Not palatable except when young.

No. 202. Cultivated, Lorenzo R. Parodi Grass Garden. Feb. 6. Bunchgrass about 3 feet tall; palatable only when young.

162777. *ANDROPOGON SACCHAROIDES* Swartz.

Silver beardgrass.

No. 200. In city park. Feb. 6. Plants 18 to 24 inches tall; common in native pastures over a major part of Argentina and Uruguay; palatable.
