162886. *CAPSICUM FRUTESCENS* L. Solanaceae. **Redpepper.**
No. 253. Along railroad near Puerto Casado. Feb. 19.
162887. *CHLORIS POLYDACTYLA* (L.) Swartz. Poaceae.
No. 249. In heavy moist soil along railroad at Puerto Casado. Feb. 19. A tufted, fairly leafy grass.
162888. *TRICHLORIS MENDOCINA* (Phil.) Kurtz. Poaceae.
No. 251. Common along railroad near Puerto Casado. Feb. 19. Erect tufted grass, 3 to 4 feet high with much-branched culms.
- 162889 and 162890. *CUCURBITA MAXIMA* Duchesne. Cucurbitaceae. **Squash.**
162889. No. 212. Near Caacupé. Feb. 14. Fruit pear-shaped, with short, thick neck, about 2 pounds in weight; flesh yellow.
162890. No. 242. Vicinity of Concepción. Feb. 20. Fruit deeply lobed, 1 to 2 pounds in weight; flesh firm, thick, yellow.
162891. *AESCHYNOMENE FALCATA* (Poir.) DC. Fabaceae.
No. 221. Between Caacupé and Paraguari. Feb. 14.
162892. *DIGITARIA LEANTHA* (Hack.) Parodi. Poaceae.
No. 240. Open prairie near Fonciera. Feb. 19. Cespitose, 4 feet tall, foliage tough.
162893. *ERAGROSTIS EXPANSA* Link. Poaceae.
No. 214. Along road between Caacupé and Paraguari. Feb. 14. Erect, 20 inches high.
162894. *ERIOSEMA TACUAREMBOENSE* Arech. Fabaceae.
No. 224. Colonia Pirareta, between Piribebuy and Paraguari. Feb. 14. Erect, 3 feet or less; leaves large, trifoliate; flowers yellow.
162895. *GOSSYPIUM*. Malvaceae. **Cotton.**
No. 222. Southeast of Asunción. Feb. 14. Upland type cotton.
162896. *HYPARRHENIA RUFA* (Nees) Stapf. Poaceae.
No. 237. *Yaraguay*. Open prairie near Fonciera. Feb. 18. Foliage fine and tender.
162897. *MIMOSA INCANA* (Spreng.) Benth. Fabaceae.
No. 228. Colonia Pirareta, between Piribebuy and Paraguari. Feb. 14. Bush 4 to 5 feet tall.
162898. *NICOTIANA TABACUM* L. Solanaceae. **Tobacco.**
No. 236. On river bank at Fonciera. Feb. 18. Plant 30 inches high; leaves narrow.
162899. *PAPPOPHORUM SUBBULBOSUM* Arech. Poaceae.
No. 250. Near Puerto Casado. Feb. 18. Tufted perennial with fair basal foliage; culms ascending, 2 to 3 feet tall, panicles purplish.
162900. *PAPPOPHORUM PAPPIFERUM* (Lam.) Ktze.
No. 252. Near Puerto Casado. Feb. 18. Large bunchgrass with glabrous foliage; resembles tall fescue.
- 162901 to 162906. *PASPALUM* spp. Poaceae.
- 162901 and 162902. *PASPALUM NOTATUM* Fluegge. **Bahia grass.**
162901. No. 215. Between Caacupé and Paraguari. Feb. 14.
162902. No. 261. Roadside near Caacupé. Feb. 24. Broad-leaved type; formerly fairly dense sod.
162903. *PASPALUM SECANS* Hitchc. & Chase.
No. 234. Low, wet prairie near Fonciera. Feb. 19. Tough bunchgrass, 3 to 4 feet high.
