164633. No. 9057. *Pushani*. Fruit subglobose, grass-green marked with darker green; rind ¾ inches thick; flesh handsome pink, of good texture but low in sugar.
164634. No. 9058. *Pushani*. Fruit globose, sea-green rib-lined with darker green; rind ½ to ¾ inch thick; flesh pink, good texture but low in sugar.
164635. *CUCUMIS MELO* L. Cucurbitaceae. **Muskmelon.**  
No. 9059. Fruit flattened, 10 by 6 inches, deep-ribbed, traces of net, orange; flesh 1½ inches thick, salmon, insipid.
164636. *CITRULLUS VULGARIS* Schrad. Cucurbitaceae. **Watermelon.**  
No. 9060. *Pushani*. Fruit globose, sea-green faintly marked with darker green; rind exceptionally firm.
164637. *CUCUMIS MELO* L. Cucurbitaceae. **Muskmelon.**
