183307. No. 11502. *Phut*. Raipur, Central Provinces. Mar. 6. Fruit elongate pyriform, 8 inches in diameter, smooth, dull-lemon with traces of dark blotches; flesh pale-salmon, mealy, edible. Seed cavity solid.
