231660. 'Leopold'. Spontaneous variation of 'Royal Emile'. A juicy and delicately flavored grape but a poor cropper with considerable variation.

231661. 'Ribier'. Introduced into Belgium in 1936. Ripens midseason.

231662. 'Royal'. Growing in the greenhouses of the Belgium Royal Palace at Laeken. Fruit deep black; about the size as 'Ribier'; heavy cropper.
