232551. *BERBERIS HAEMATOCARPA* Wooton Berberidaceae. **Barberry.**

No. 536. Gravelly pine slope, 11 miles east of Jacob Lake, Route 89, Coconino County, Arizona. Plant 10 feet high; leaf cut; fruit pink; possible ornamental.

232552. *BETULA GLANDULOSA* Michx. Betulaceae. **Bog birch.**

No. 414. Edge of spruce grove bordering Belly River, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana.

232553. *DICENTRA FORMOSA* (Andr.) DC. Papaveraceae. **Pacific bleeding-heart.**

No. 48. Exposed rock surface, Summit of Mount Hershberger, Douglas County, Oregon. Elevation 6,200 feet.

232554. *DRYAS DRUMMONDII* Richards Rosaceae.

No. 415. Rocky island in Belly River, 2 miles south of Canadian border, Glacier County, Montana.

232555. *ERYTHRONIUM* sp. Liliaceae.

No. 86. Cold Spring Lookout, 12 miles northwest of Riggins near Seven Devils Mountain, Idaho County, Idaho.

232556 to 232558. *EUROTIA LANATA* (Pursh) Miq. Chenopodiaceae. **Common winterfat.**

232556. No. 343. Over-grazed dry field 4 miles south of Choteau, Route 33, Teton County, Montana.

232557. No. 533. Rabbit-sagebrush plain, 4 miles west of Bryce Canyon, Dixie National Forest, Utah.

232558. No. 238. Rabbit-sagebrush plain, 24 miles south of Cameron, Route 89A, Yavapai County, Arizona.

232559. *GENTIANA ELEGANS* A. Nels. Gentianaceae.

No. 486. Sedge meadow, Swan Lake, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming.

232560. *HEDYSARUM SULPHURESCENS* Rydb. Fabaceae. **Sweetvetch.**

No. 350. Exposed eastern slope, 4 miles south of Kiowa near Medicine Ridge, Route 49, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 5,900 feet.

232561 and 232562. *JUNIPERUS COMMUNIS* var. *SAXATILIS* Pallas Pinaceae. **Juniper.**

232561. No. 359. East of Mt. Altyn and southwest of Swiftcurrent Lake, Appekunny Mountain, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plant depressed, almost prostrate.

232562. No. 480. Along Madison River, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Elevation 6,500 feet.

232563. *KALLSTROEMIA GRANDIFLORA* Torr. Zygophyllaceae.

No. 540. Desert, about 42 feet below sea level, near Yuma County line, 16 miles east of Datel, Route 80, Yuma County, Arizona.

232564. *LATHYRUS VESTITUS* var. *PUBERULUS* (White) Jeps. Fabaceae. **Peavine.**

No. 1. Roadside redwood grove, 3 miles north of Gorda, Monterey County, California. Plant 3 feet high, upright.

232565. *LEPTARRHENA PYRIFOLIA* (D. Don) R. Br. Saxifragaceae.

No. 389. Meadow on eastern slope, Logan Pass, Clements Mountain (Hanging Gardens), Glacier National Park, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet.
