No. 509. Dry slope of Mount Washburne, 0.5 mile north of Dunraven Pass, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming.

232583. *MIMULUS GUTTATUS* DC. Scrophulariaceae.

No. 137. Along stream, Wheeler Springs near Snow Basin, Mount Ogden, Wasatch Range, Weber County, Utah. Flowers yellow.

232584. *ORTHOCARPUS TENUIFOLIUS* (Pursh) Benth. Scrophulariaceae.

No. 329. Sauerkraut Creek near Lincoln, Lewis and Clark County, Montana. Elevation 4,900 feet.

232585 to 232588. *OXYTROPIS DEFLEXA* var. *SERICEA* Torr. & Gray Fabaceae.

232585. No. 209. Sandy clay, northwest shore of Green River Lake, Bridger National Forest, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet.

232586. No. 244. Willows, gravelly roadside bordering Half Moon Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming.

232587. No. 419. Meadow, Belly River, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 4,800 feet.

232588. No. 490. Site of Mammoth's water supply, Gardiner Creek, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming.

232589. *OXYTROPIS LAMBERTII* var. *BIGELOVII* Gray

No. 539. Gravelly slope, Route 89, 18 miles north of Flagstaff, Coconino County, Arizona. Elevation 7,200 feet.

232590. *OXYTROPIS OREOPHILA* Gray

No. 532. Rocky slope in yellow pine grove, Inspiration Point, Bryce Canyon, Utah. Ornamental possibilities.

232591. *OXYTROPIS SERICEA* Nutt.

No. 345. Dry meadow, 4 miles south of Choteau, Route 89, Pondera County, Montana.

232592. *OXYTROPIS SPLENDENS* Richards

No. 360. Gravel along bridle path, east of Mount Altyn, southwest of Swiftcurrent Lake, Appekunny Mountain, Glacier County, Montana. Plant prostrate, very pubescent, silver-woolly appearing; fruiting stem upright.

232593 and 232594. *OXYTROPIS VISCIDA* Nutt.

232593. No. 351. Rocky bank bordering aspen woods, 1 mile south of Junction 89, Route 49, Glacier National Park, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 6,000 feet.

232594. No. 511. Sagebrush hill, edge of lodgepole pinewoods, Tower Falls Campgrounds, Yellowstone National Park, Wyoming. Elevation 6,000 feet.

232595. *PEDICULARIS GROENLANDICA* Retz. Scrophulariaceae. **Woodbetony.**

No. 228. Green River Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Plant very showy.

232596. *PENSTEMON CONFERTUS* Dougl. Scrophulariaceae.

No. 262. Six miles northwest of Southpass City, Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming.

232597. *PENSTEMON ELLIPTICUS* Coult. & Fisch.

No. 370. Dry ledge, trail to Grinnell Glacier, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 6,000 feet. Flowers purple.
