232614. No. 375. Rocky moraine, Grinnell Glacier, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 8,400 feet. Plant 3 feet high; creeping.

232615. No. 381. Meadow on eastern slope, Logan Pass, Clements Mountain, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet.

232616. No. 382. Meadow on eastern slope, Logan Pass, Clements Mountain, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 7,000 feet. Plant 2 inches high; capsules red.

232617. No. 529. Tundra near Beartooth Pass, Park County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,000 feet.

232618. *SAXIFRAGA ARGUTA* Don. Saxifragaceae. **Brook saxifrage.**

No. 212. Mossy stream bank, lodgepole pine forest, Green River Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet.

232619. *THERMOPSIS XYLORHIZA* Nels. Fabaceae.

No. 81. Edge of fir woods about 4 miles below Cold Springs Lookout, Cold Spring Road, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 6,600 feet.

232620. *TRIFOLIUM LATIFOLIUM* (Hook.) Greene. Fabaceae. **Twin clover.**

No. 80. One mile below Cold Springs Lookout, Idaho County, Idaho. Elevation 6,800 feet. Plants creeping, not light sensitive, forming beds in shady spots; color heads pink to white; heavy seeders.

232621. *TRIFOLIUM PARRYI* Gray. **Clover.**

No. 530. Rocky tundra near Beartooth Pass, Route 12, Park County, Wyoming. Elevation 10,500 feet. Seed heads erect about 2 inches from ground.

232622 to 232626. *TRIFOLIUM RYDBERGHII* Greene. **Clover.**

232622. No. 150. Lodgepole pine meadow along Middle Fork of Sheeps Creek, road to Spirit Lake, Daggett County, Utah. Elevation 9,000 feet.

232623. No. 216. Lodgepole pine meadow, Green River Lake, Sublette County, Wyoming. Elevation 9,000 feet. Plants abundant.

232624. No. 258. Lodgepole pine woods, 6 miles northwest of Southpass City, along Pine Creek, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 7,100 feet.

232625. No. 289. Aspen woods, 24 miles southwest of Dubois, Route 87, Fremont County, Wyoming. Elevation 8,500 feet. Plants abundant.

232626. No. 488. In moist thicket of dwarf willows, Gardiner Creek, Yellowstone National Park.

232627. *VANCOUVERIA HEXANDRA* (Hook.) Morr. & Dene. Berberidaceae.

No. 62. Shrine of Our Lady of Sorrows, Portland, Oregon.

232628. *VICIA AMERICANA* Muhl. Fabaceae. **American vetch.**

No. 356. Rocky trail east of Mount Altyn, northwest of Swiftcurrent Lake, Appekunny Mountain, Glacier County, Montana. Elevation 6,000 feet.

232629 to 232649. *COFFEA ARABICA* L. Rubiaceae. **Arabian coffee.**
