234726. Col. No. 16123. Cultivated pasture, Pleurtuit, Brittany. Spontaneous annual.

234727. *TRIFOLIUM LAPPACEUM* L. Fabaceae.

Lappa clover.

Col. No. 16077. Stony ground 18 km. northwest of Montpellier. Diffuse winter annual; seeds heavy.

234728. *TRIFOLIUM PRATENSE* L. Fabaceae.

Red clover.

Col. No. 16121. Old meadow, Montomban, 30 km. west of Rennes. Solitary plant.

234729. *TRIFOLIUM TOMENTOSUM* L.

Wooly clover.

Col. No. 16092. Ten km. southwest of Montpellier. Winter and spring annual.

234730. *TRIFOLIUM* sp.

Col. No. 16093. Ten km. southwest of Montpellier. Thick diffuse colony; winter and spring annual; seeding heavily.

234731. *VICIA LUTEA* L. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 16074. Eighteen km. northwest of Montpellier. Viny annual herb.
