Col. No. 16138. Rocky, clay soil over limestone near Soubernon, Cote d'Or.

Red clover.

234955. Col. No. 16125. Near Soubernon, Cote d'Or. Spontaneous perennial, erect to spreading, sparsely pubescent.

234956. Col. No. 16137. Dry, rocky, clay soil near Soubernon, Cote d'Or. One plant.

234957. Col. No. 16139. Dry rocky location near Soubernon, Cote d'Or. One plant.

234958. Col. No. 16144. Nine km. west of Saulieu. Plant slender, stunted.

234959. Col. No. 16146. About 5 km. west of Saulieu. Seeds from one plant; cold hardy.

234960 and 234961. *TRIFOLIUM REPENS* L. Fabaceae.

White clover.

234960. Col. No. 16140. Seven km. west of Saulieu. Wild type; flowers pale pink.

234961. Col. No. 16147. About 5 km. west of Saulieu. Spontaneous; flowers pale pink.
