Col. No. 492. Limestone ravines, Iwoji City, Kochi-ken. Plant wild, 2.5 feet high, aroid; leaves ternately divided; corm round, 2 inches in diameter.

235248. *ARISAEMA TOSAENSE* Mak.

Col. No. 517. On Zozusan Mountain, Kotahira, Kagawa-ken. Perennial; leaves palmate; flowers green; fruit red.

Sasanqua camellia.

235249. Col. No. 509. Between Shimizu and Nakamura, Tosa-ken.

Plant wild; leaves small; petals narrow.

235250. Col. No. 510. Flowers large, white, single.
 235251. Col. No. 511. Flowers large, white, semidouble.
 235252. Col. No. 512. Flowers large, dark red, single.
 235253. Col. No. 513. Flowers large, pink, single.
 235254. Col. No. 514. Flowers small, dark pink.
 235255. Col. No. 515. Flowers medium, pink and white, single.
 235256. Col. No. 516. Flowers medium, anemone, pink.

235257. *CHRYSANTHEMUM SHIWOGIKU* Kitamura Asteraceae.

Col. No. 484. Along sandy beach, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken. Plant wild, prostrate; some branches ascending; leaves thick, pubescent beneath; flowers in December, yellow.

235258. *CORYLOPSIS SPICATA* Sieb. & Zucc. Hammamelidaceae.

Col. No. 494. On shale, endemic to Kochi-ken, Wild, deciduous shrub, to 6 feet high; leaves broadly ovate; flowers bright yellow, before leaves.
