235420. *ARISAEMA SHIKOKIANUM* Franch. & Sav. Araceae.

Col. No. 518. In woods at Zetzusan, Kotohira, Kagawa-ken, Shikoku. Perennial, 2 feet high; flower pure white; central column purplish, much inflated at tip; berries red.

235421. *ARISAEMA TOSAENSE* Mak.

Col. No. 517. In woods at Zetzusan, Kotohira, Kagawa-ken, Shikoku.

235422. *CAMELLIA SASANQUA* Thunb. Theaceae. **Sasanqua camellia.**

Col. No. 512. Zetzusan, Kotohira, Kagawa-ken, Shikoku.

235423. *CORYLOPSIS SPICATA* Sieb. & Zucc. Hamamelidaceae.

Col. No. 494. On serpentine hill, Kochi, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Deciduous shrub; flowers bright yellow, before the leaves.

***235424.** *DAPHNIPHYLLUM GLAUDESCENS* Blume Euphorbiaceae.

Col. No. 475. Tree evergreen, to 30 feet high; leaves lanceolate, glaucous beneath; flowers unisexual, greenish; fruits black when ripe.

235425. *EURYA EMARGINATA* (Thunb.) Makino Theaceae.

Col. No. 485. Along beach areas, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Dense, spreading, dioecious, evergreen shrub; leaves elliptic, emarginate; flowers pale yellow, hanging beneath leaves in profusion; fruits black.

235426. *ILEX SERRATA* var. *SIEBOLDI* Loes. Aquifoliaceae. **Holly.**

Col. No. 495. On serpentine hills, above Kochi City, Kochi-ken. Plant deciduous; fruits in a cyme, red, rather small; 4 seeded.

235427. *INDIGOFERA PSEUDOTINCTORIA* Mats. Fabaceae. **Indigo.**

Col. No. 480. Along seacoast in sand, Muroto-zaki, Kochi-ken, Shikoku. Prostrate deciduous shrub; stems erect to decumbent, some specimens 3 feet across; flowers purple-pink; good ground cover.
