235985. *SYMPLOCOS LUCIDA* Sieb. & Zucc. Symplocaceae. **Sweetleaf.**

Col. No. 747. Along sunny road, Furuta National Forest, Tanegashima. Evergreen shrub to 8 feet high; leaves alternate, ovate, slightly crenate; fruits black.

235986. *TROPIDIA NIPPONICA* Masamune Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 744. Damp humus along river, Furuta National Forest, Tanegashima. Small terrestrial; leaves ovate; veins prominent.

* **235987.** *PHAJUS* sp. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 727. Along shady bank of river near Koseda, Yakushima. Large terrestrial; flowers pink.

* **235988.** *TRICHOMANES* sp. Hymenophyllaceae.

Col. No. 731. Along stream, Tachimoto National Forest, Tanegashima. Climbing, handsome, evergreen fern; fronds laceolate, deeply cut, transparent.

* **235989.** *OBERONIA* sp. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 732. Stream bed, Tachimoto National Forest, Tanegashima. Small, epiphyte; dichotomous branching.

* **235990.** *ORCHIS* sp. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 768. Onigasawa Forest, Tanegashima. Terrestrial; leaves large; flowers white, 50 or more on a stalk.

* **235991.** *CITRUS ASSAMENSIS* Dutta & Bhatt. Rutaceae.

From India. Seeds presented by the District Agricultural Officer, Shillong, Assam, through the Agricultural Attache, New Delhi.
