236080. CITRUS PONKI Hayata Rutaceae.

Col. No. 725. Orchards at Kurio and Onoaida, Yakushima. Nov. 11, 1956. Large, loose skin mandarin; very sweet; good texture.

236081. CITRUS TACHIBANA (Makino) Tanaka

Col. No. 770. Rocky bank of stream, Onigasawa Forest, Tanegashima. Dec. 5, 1956. Fruits about the size of plum; skin loose.

236082. CITRUS sp.

Col. No. 648. Citrus orchard, Nagata. Nov. 22, 1956. Fruits small; skin loose; used as stock for *Citrus ponki*.

236083. VIBURNUM TRILOBUM Marsh. Caprifoliaceae.

From the United States. Seeds held at the Regional Plant Introduction Garden, Geneva, New York. Numbered Dec. 27, 1956.

Collected Oct. 1, 1956, roadside, Acton, Me., by E. M. Meader. Plant to 12 feet high; unusually good cluster of red fruits; used for making jelly.
