236846. Col. No. 312. Northeastern slope Mount Edith Cavell, Jasper National Park. Plant densely caespitose; culms 1 foot high; decumbent.

236847 to 236852. *FESTUCA SCABRELLA* Torr. **Rough fescue.**

236847. Col. No. 139. Dry field 17 miles north of Coleman, Coleman-Kananaskis Road. Plant 4 feet high, forming large clumps.

236848. Col. No. 146. Table land of lodgepole pine 8 miles north of Dutch Creek, Coleman-Kananaskis Road. Elevation 5,090 feet. Plant 4 feet high.

236849. Col. No. 325. Two miles east of Fort Saskatchewan.

236850. Col. No. 326. Four miles east of Fort Saskatchewan.

236851. Col. No. 327. One mile east of Fort Saskatchewan.

236852. Col. No. 330. One-half mile east of Fort Saskatchewan.

236853. *FRAGARIA GLAUCA* (S. Wats.) Rydb. Rosaceae. **Blueleaf strawberry.**

Col. No. 131. Clearing in lodgepole pine woods 4 miles north of Coleman, Coleman-Kananaskis Road.

236854. *FRAGARIA* sp.

Col. No. 303. Spruce woods 4.5 miles south of Cadomin, along the McLeod Road to Mountain Park. Plant 6 inches high; fruits large.

236855. *GEOCAULON LIVIDUM* (Richards.) Fernald Santalaceae.

Col. No. 178. Open spruce woods on bank of Kootenay River, Kootenay National Park, British Columbia, near McCleod Creek. Plant 10 inches high; fruits bright orange.

236856. *JUNIPERUS HORIZONTALIS* Moench. Pinaceae. **Creeping juniper.**

Col. No. 213. Sandy shelf overlooking the Ghost River.

236857 and 236858. *LATHYRUS OCHROLEUCUS* Hook. Fabaceae. **Peavine.**

236857. Col. No. 176. Banff.

236858. Col. No. 266. Along Sturgeon Lake, 3 miles west of Calais.

236859. *LEPTARRHENA PYROLIFOLIA* (D. Don) R. Br. Saxifragaceae.

Col. No. 174. Sunshine Ski Lodge, 12 miles south of Banff, Banff National Park. Elevation 7,300 feet.

236860. *LOMATIUM SIMPLEX* var. *LEPTOPHYLLUM* (Hook.) Mathias Apiaceae

Col. No. 12. Crowsnest Pass, 4 miles west of Coleman on plateau in gravelly soil. Elevation 4,450 feet.

236861. *LOMATIUM* sp.

Col. No. 34. Lodgepole pine woods clearing, 4 miles north of Coleman, Coleman-Kananaskis Road.

236862. *LOTUS PURSHIANUS* (Benth.) Clements & Clements Fabaceae. **Trefoil.**

Col. No. 49. Parkland meadow, road to Dominion Experiment Plots at Pass Lake, 10 miles north of Kamloops, British Columbia. Elevation 1,600 feet. Plant 8 inches high; heavy seed producer.

Col. No. 111. Four miles west of Coleman.

236864 and 236865. *LUPINUS POLYPHYLLUS* Lindl. **Washington lupine.**

236864. Col. No. 83. Nine miles east of Creston, British Columbia.

236865. Col. No. 133. Clearing in lodgepole slope, 4 miles north of Coleman, Coleman-Kananaskis Road; associated with vetch and Douglas-fir.
