238759. ADENOCARPUS COMPLICATUS (L.) J. Gay Fabaceae.

Col. No. 3779. Rocky meadow near the top of the Serra do Caramulo. Elevation 2,400 feet. Much-branched shrub to 6 feet high; leaves small, 3-foliate; flowers yellow, streaked red.

238760. ANAGYRIS FOETIDA L. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 3763. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Ashy-grey deciduous bush to 5 feet high; leaves 3-foliate; flowers yellow, pea-shaped.

238761. ANTHYLLIS HERMANNIAE L. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 3747. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Much-branched evergreen shrub to 4 feet high; branches spine-tipped; leaves narrow, linear; flowers yellow.

238762. ANTIRRHINUM LINKIANUM Boiss. & Rent. Scrophulariaceae.**Snapdragon.**

Col. No. 3768. Serra do Sico, near Ramalhaes, west of Pombal. Flowers pink.

238763. ARISTOTELIA CHILENSIS (Mol.) Stuntz Elaeocarpaceae. Macqui.

Col. No. 3770. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Evergreen tree to 15 feet high; leaves to 4 inches long, lustrous green; flowers small, white.

238764. BOUGAINVILLEA GLABRA Choisy ex DC. Nyctaginaceae.

Col. No. 3766. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. 'Maud Chettlebourg'. Large scrambling shrub.

238765. BUDDLEIA CORDATA H.B.K. Loganiaceae.**Butterflybush.**

Col. No. 3764. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Shrub to 10 feet.

238766. CESTRUM PURPUREUM (Lindl.) Standl. Solanaceae.

Col. No. 3775. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Evergreen shrub to 6 feet high; branches arching, shoots downy; flowers reddish-purple, in pendulous clusters; very floriferous.

238767. CYTISUS PENDULINUS L. f. Fabaceae.**Broom.**

Col. No. 3781. Mountain side, Serra do Caramulo. Shrub to 10 feet high; branches arching; flowers deep yellow.
