238866. *THYSANOLAENA MAXIMA* (Roxb.) Kuntze Poaceae.

Col. No. 614. Bulolo. Mar. 26, 1957. Elevation 2,350 feet.

238867. *ANTHURIUM DIGITATUM* G. Don Araceae.

Col. No. 3744. Greenhouse, Botanical Garden, Coimbra. A handsome foliage species; leaves deep green, lustrous, leathery, digitately divided, to 8 inches wide; petioles to 3 feet long.

238868. *APOLLONIAS CANARIENSIS* Nees Lauraceae.

Col. No. 3750. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Handsome evergreen tree to 20 feet high, much-branched and forming a round crown; leaves to 5 inches long, aromatic.

238869. *BENCOMIA CAUDATA* Webb & Berth. Rosaceae.

Col. No. 3749. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Small shrub.

238870. *CAMELLIA JAPONICA* L. Theaceae.

Common camellia.

Col. No. 3740. Palace Hotel garden, Bussaco, northeast of Coimbra. Leaves very dark green, unusually thick; flowers formal, pure white; very floriferous.

238871. *DRYANDRA* sp. Proteaceae.

Col. No. 3735. Moreira da Silva Nursery, Porto. Small evergreen tree; leaves green above, white below.

238872. *GREWIA POPULIFOLIA* Vahl Tiliaceae.

Col. No. 3752. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Evergreen tree to 20 feet high.

238873. *HALLERIA LUCIDA* L. Scrophulariaceae.

Col. No. 3748. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Shrub to 10 feet high; flowers tubular, reddish-yellow.

238874. *HEBANTHE PANICULATA* (Moq.) Benth. & Hook. Amaranthaceae.

Col. No. 3746. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Vigorous climber; flowers whitish.

238875. *KOHLERIA AMABILIS* (Planch. & Lind.) Fritsch Gesneriaceae.

Col. No. 3742. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Perennial; leaves hairy, large, red-speckled; flowers pouchlike. 'Longwood'.

238876. *ADHATODA VASICA* Nees Acanthaceae.

Col. No. 3751. Botanical Garden, Coimbra. Shrub to 8 feet high; flowers white.

238877 and 238878. *NARCISSUS BULBOCODIUM* L. Amaryllidaceae.

Petticoat daffodil.

238877. Col. No. 3739. Grassy meadows along Penacova-Liso road, 12 miles from Coimbra. A hexaploid form, nearly 1 foot high. (Bulbs.)
