Col. No. 3802. Along open, rocky slopes, Mediterranean Coast, west of Motril, Malaga. (Cuttings.)

239058. *GLADIOLUS ILLYRICUS* Koch Iridaceae.

Col. No. 3796. Dry, rocky, south facing slopes, 12 miles southwest of Seville. Plant to 14 inches high; flowers rose-red. (Bulbs.)

239059. *HEDERA HELIX* L. Araliaceae. **English ivy.**

Col. No. 3795. Nursery of Viversa Andres, Seville. Plant extremely vigorous; young leaves large. (Cuttings.)

239060. *IRIS SISYRINCHIUM* L. Iridaceae. **Moraea iris.**

Col. No. 3797. Southeast of Seville. (Bulbs.)

239061 and 239062. *NARCISSUS BULBOCODIUM* L. Amaryllidaceae.
Petticoat daffodil.**239061.** Col. No. 3794. Wet swale on open hill slopes near Val de Flores, 35 miles north of Seville. Plant to 8 inches high. (Bulbs.)**239062.** Col. No. 3794. Seeds of 239061.**239063.** *NARCISSUS JONQUILLA* L.

Col. No. 3792. Among stones and sand along banks of Rio Guardiana near Serpa. Flowers yellow; leaves grasslike. (Bulbs.)

239064. *NERIUM OLEANDER* L. Apocynaceae. **Oleander.**

Col. No. 3805. Open rocky hillsides and in canyons along Mediterranean coast at Motril, Province Granada. Evergreen shrub to 8 feet high; flowers deep pink. Wild form. (Cuttings.)

239065. *PAEONIA OFFICINALIS* L. Ranunculaceae. **Peony.**

Col. No. 3793. Woods in stony red soil, Sierra Aracena, about 1.5 miles west of Aracena. Perennial to 2 feet high; flowers pink, 4 inches across. (Plants.)

239066. *CNEORUM TRICOCCON* L. Cneoraceae.

Col. No. 3804. Along Mediterranean Coast west of Motril, Province Malaga. Evergreen shrub; flowers yellow.

239067. *TEUCRIUM* sp. Menthaceae.

Col. No. 3798. Southeast of Seville along road N. 334. Stiff erect shrub to 14 inches high; leaves aromatic, dimorphic.

239068. *ODONTOSPERMUM MARITIMUM* Sch.-Bip. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 3799. East of Malaga along road following Mediterranean Sea. Plant mostly decumbent; flowers yellow. (Cuttings.)
