Col. No. 3801. Along Mediterranean Coast east of Malaga. Erect aromatic perennial; flowers small, white. (Cuttings.)

239071. *GENISTA EQUISETIFORMIS* Spach Fabaceae.

Col. No. 3803. Along rocky slopes of Mediterranean Coast west of Motril. Plant densely branched; stems gray-green; flowers chartruese. (Cuttings.)

239076. *BOEHMERIA BILOBA* Wedd. Urticaceae.

Col. No. 3813. Botanical Garden, Madrid. Apr. 18, 1957. Coarse perennial to 30 inches high; leaves to 6 inches long, bright green, roughened, often 2 to 3 lobed. (Cuttings.)

239077. *CENISTA CINEREA* DC. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 3808. Road to Jaen. Apr. 17, 1957. Densely branched plant to 4 feet high; flowers deep yellow. (Plant.)

239078. *CYTISUS SCOPARIUS* (L.) Link**Scotch broom.**

Col. No. 3809. Along river bank, 6 miles north of Jaen. Much-branched shrub to 3 feet high; flowers deep yellow. (Plant.)

239079. *FRAXINUS EXCELSIOR* L. Oleaceae.**European ash.**

Col. No. 3807. 'Pendula'. Jardim de l'Ile Aranjuez, Madrid. Apr. 17, 1957. Deciduous tree; branches pendulous. (Scions.)

239080. *JUNIPERUS OXYCEDRUS* L. Pinaceae.**Prickly juniper.**

Col. No. 3811. Among granite boulders near El Escorial, Province Madrid. Apr. 18, 1957. Tree to 30 feet high. (Seeds.)

239081. *JUNIPERUS SABINA* L.**Savin juniper.**

Col. No. 3806. Open rocky mountain slopes, Sierra Nevada Mountains. Elevation 6,000 feet. Apr. 15, 1957. Prostrate shrub to 14 inches high; branches spreading. (Cuttings.)
