Col. No. 3818. Shrub to 10 feet high; leaves pinnately divided.

**239249.** *NERIUM OLEANDER* L. Apocynaceae. **Oleander.**

Col. No. 3823. 'Aurantiacum'. Flowers orange-yellow with white center.

**239250.** *OREOPANAX ECHINOPS* Decne. & Planch. Araliaceae.

Col. No. 3824. Evergreen tree to 25 feet high; leaves digitately divided. Ornamental.

**239251.** *OSMANTHUS* sp. Oleaceae.

Col. No. 3819. Large evergreen shrub to 12 feet high; leaves to 3 inches long, acuminate.

**239252.** *VINCA MAJOR* L. Apocynaceae. **Periwinkle.**

Col. No. 3820. 'Pubescens'. Leaves narrow; flowers rose-violet; petals pointed.

**239253.** *OREOPANAX ECHINOPS* Decne. & Planch. Araliaceae.

Col. No. 3830. Evergreen tree to 20 feet high; leaves digitately 3-foliate, hairy; handsome.
