Col. No. 3826. Garden, Menton-Garavan, Alpes-Maritimes. Apr. 25, 1957. Sprawling shrub; leaves woolly; flowers yellow.

239335. *SARCOCOCCA SALIGNA* (D. Don.) Muell.-Arg. **Buxaceae.**

Col. No. 3827. Garden of Major Lawrence Johnston, Serre de la Madone, Val du Gorbio, Alpes-Maritimes. Apr. 25, 1957. Evergreen shrub to 4 feet high; leaves acuminate, lanceolate-oblong.
