240073. CENTAUREA VERBASCIFOLIA Vahl Asteraceae.

Col. No. 3956. Half-woody subshrub to 4 feet high; leaves to 8 inches long
and 4 inches wide, green above, white tomentose beneath; flower heads lav-
ender. Probably hardy in frostless regions only.

240074. FICUS ALTISSIMA Blume Moraceae.**Lofty fig.**

Col. No. 3964. Large evergreen tree to 50 feet high.

240075. FICUS MAGNOLIODES Borzi**Fig.**

Col. No. 3960. Large evergreen tree to 60 feet high; stilt-roots; leaves to
8 inches long, lustrous, deep green. Ornamental.

240076. HETEROPTERYS CHRYSOPHYLLA H. B. K. Malpighiaceae.

Col. No. 3958. Scrambling or half erect evergreen shrub; leaves shiny
green above, silvery tomentose below.

240077. SALMEA SCANDENS (L.) DC. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 3959. Scrambling, evergreen, twining vine; flowers all discoid.

240078. TARCHONANTHUS CAMPHORATUS L. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 3957. Large evergreen shrub; leaves green above, silvery tomen-
tose beneath; flower heads purple.

240079. GLYCINE MAX (L.) Merr. Fabaceae.**Soybean.**
