240524. *AESCLUSUS HIPPOCASTANUM* L. Aesculaceae.

Common horsechestnut.

Col. No. 4017. 'Laciniata'. Botanical Garden, University of Florence. Deciduous tree to 40 feet high; foliage fernlike, leaflets narrow, deeply incised.

240525. *ALLIUM NIGRUM* L. Liliaceae.

Col. No. 4013. Giardini di Marignolle, Florence. Ornamental onion; leaves dark green, 6 inches long, 2 inches wide, recurved; flowers umbellate, white, terminal on scapes to 30 inches high. (Bulbs.)

240526. *MYOPORUM LAETUM* Forst. Myoporaceae.

Col. No. 4031. Botanical Garden, University of Florence. Small tree; leaves light green, pellucid dots.

240527. *BEGONIA REX* Putz. Begoniaceae.

Col. No. 4014. Giardini de Marignolle, Florence. Leaves blackish-red, slightly mottled with a metallic sheen. (Plant.)

240528. *BUXUS SEMPERVIRENS* L. Buxaceae. **Common box.**

Col. No. 4016. 'Rosmarinifolia'. Botanical Garden, University of Florence. Evergreen shrub; leaves rosemarylike, small, narrowly linear.

240529. *COTONEASTER SALICIFOLIA* Franch. Malaceae.

Col. No. 4015. 'Prostrata'. Giardini di Marignolle, Florence. Semievergreen prostrate shrub; leaves lanceolate, 1 inch long, lustrous, white-felted below; berries bright red.
