240811. *CROSSANDRA NILOTICA* Oliver Acanthaceae.

Col. No. 4096. Perennial to 2 feet high; leaves ovate-acuminate, about 4 inches long, pubescent; flowers in dense spikes, salmon-red.

240812. *MAESA* sp. Myrsinaceae.

Col. No. 4110. Perennial; leaves alternate, ovate.

240813. *PELARGONIUM ZONALE* (L.) L'Her. Geraniaceae.

Horseshoe geranium.

Col. No. 4094. 'Millionaire'. Extremely vigorous cultivar; inflorescence 6 inches across and flowers to 2 inches in diameter; salmon-pink.

240814. *MONTANAO TOMENTOSA* Cerv. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 4112. Much-branched shrub to 12 feet high; leaves pubescent; ray flowers white.

240819. *CHRYSANTHEMUM* sp. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 4109. Much-branched perennial to 3 feet high; leaves finely divided, glaucous; flowers white.

240820. *CISSUS STRIATA* Ruiz & Pav. Vitaceae.

Striped treebine.

Col. No. 4108. Perennial climber; leaves digitately 5-lobed, the leaflets to 2 inches long, dark reddish-green.

240821. *CONVOLVULUS MAURITANICUS* Boiss. Convolvulaceae.

Morocco convolvulus.

Col. No. 4104. 'Sabatius'. Creeping perennial; flowers deep blue.

240822. *DISCHIDIA BENGALENSIS* Colebr. Asclepidaceae.

Col. No. 4102. Succulent-leaved epiphyte; leaves oblong-lanceolate, flat; flowers inconspicuous.

240823. *PEPEROMIA RESEDAEFLORA* Linden & Andre Piperaceae.

Col. No. 4103. Perennial to 6 inches high; stems succulent; leaves metallic, green above, glistening green below.

240824. *PILEA NUMMULARIAEFOLIA* Wedd. Urticaceae.

Col. No. 4105. Much-branched creeping perennial.
