240883. Col. No. 16592. East of Hermosillo. Wild, ornamental tree; branches arching; bark shining white.
240884. Col. No. 16636. Scattered on rocky slopes, east of Moctezuma, Sonora. May 19, 1957. Elevation 3,000 feet. Small wild tree; bark white.
240885. *JACQUINIA PUNGENS* A. Gray Theophrastaceae.
 Col. No. 16670. San Bernardo, Sonora. Apr., 1957. Low, dense, wild, evergreen shrub, sensitive to hard frost; leaves pungent-tipped.
240886. *LOTUS GREENEI* (Woot. & Standl.) Ottley Fabaceae. **Trefoil.**
 Col. No. 16654. Sierra Murrieta, east of Bacanora, Sonora. May, 1957. Low, spreading, perennial herb; seeding freely.
240887. *LUFFA* sp. Cucurbitaceae.
 Col. No. 16429. Limestone soil east of Cardenez, along road to Villa Flores, Chiapas. Mar. 20, 1957. Climbing vine; fruits numerous, brindled.
240888. *MARSDENIA EDULIS* S. Wats. Asclepiadaceae.
 Col. No. 16671. San Bernardo, Sonora. Mar., 1957. Vine climbing on shrubs and trees; green fruits edible.
240889. *RANDIA LAEVIGATA* Standley Rubiaceae.
 Col. No. 16595. Sierra de Mazatan, Sonora. May 12, 1957. Low spreading tree or shrub.
240890. *TECOMA STANS* (L.) Juss. Bignoniaceae.
 Col. No. 16597. Caballitos. Sierra di Mazatan, Sonora. May 12, 1957. Wild, spreading, fine-leaved shrub.
240891. *TEPHROSIA* sp. Fabaceae.
 Col. No. 16566. About 45 miles north of Guaymas, Sonora. Perennial wild herb; flowers reddish purple; browsed by cattle when tender.
240892. (Undetermined.)
 Col. No. 16640. Mountain east of Guasabas, Sonora. May 21, 1957. Elevation 4,000 feet. Spreading shrub.
240893. *ADENIUM OBESUM* (Forsk.) Roem. & Schult. Apocynaceae.
