Col. No. 4856. Thick rhizomatous perennial; leaves deeply 3-lobed on the flowering stalks. (Plant.)

241139. *BEGONIA FUSCA* Klotzsch Begoniaceae.

Col. No. 4857. 'Maculata'. (Cuttings.)

241140. *BEGONIA SCHARFFII* Hook. f.

Col. No. 4854. Rhizomatous; leaves produce offsets from the veins.

241141. *BEGONIA* sp.

Col. No. 4853. Apparently a 'Rex' begonia, but unlike most of this group.
