- 241203.** *CONTOGRAMME JAPONICA* Hayata Polypodiaceae.

Col. No. 4084. Greenhouse, Botanical Garden, University of Genoa, Italy. Fern; leaves bi-pinnate, leathery, shiny above.

- 241204.** *HYPOESTES SANGUINOLENTA* Hook. Acanthaceae.

Col. No. 4097. Perennial herb to 18 inches high; leaves green and mottled pink above; flowers rose pink. Italy.

- 241205.** *IODINA RHOMBIFOLIA* Hook. & Arn. ex Reissek Santalaceae.

Col. No. 4851. Jardin Botanique, Les Cedres, St. Jean, Cap Ferrat. Low much-branched evergreen shrub; leaves prickly; fruit with a white fleshy aril.

- 241206.** *IPOMOEA* × *HARDINGII* Paxt. Convolvulaceae.

Col. No. 4090. Italy. Tuberous-rooted twining perennial; leaves 3-lobed; flowers rose-purple with deep purple throat.

- 241207.** *ACACIA PENDULA* A. Cunn. Mimosaceae.

Wattle.

Col. No. 4801. Branches pendulous; leaves and branches silvery.

- 241208.** *ACACIA DEALBATA* Link

Silver wattle.

Col. No. 4797. 'Mirandale'. Small evergreen tree; leaves more finely divided than in the common type.

- 241209.** *BARNARDESIA SPINOSA* L. f. Asteraceae.

Col. No. 4783. Spiny evergreen shrub; leaves dark green, lustrous, fleshy.

- 241210.** *BEGONIA ACETOSA* Vell. Begoniaceae.

Col. No. 4825. Perennial; leaves to 6 inches long, bronze-green above, lustrous, reddish below.
