Col. No. 4867. 'Variegata'. Petioles 6 inches long; leaves spotted white. (Leaf.)

241294. CYPERUS ALTERNIFOLIUS L. Cyperaceae.

Col. No. 4872. 'Gracilis'. Plant to 12 inches high. (Cuttings.)

241295. EUGENIA GUABIJU Berg Myrtaceae.

Col. No. 4938. Small evergreen tree, round-headed; leaves shiny ovate. (Cuttings.)

241296 and 241297. GAZANIA (hybrids). Asteraceae.

241296. Col. No. 4871. Much-branched perennial; leaves white tomentose below; flowers yellow with a black eye. (Cuttings.)

241297. Col. No. 4871. (Seeds.)

241298 and 241299. GAZANIA X SPLENDENS Henderson Asteraceae.

241298. Col. No. 4873. Essentially acaulescent perennial; leaves green above, silvery beneath; flowers clear yellow to base. (Cuttings.)

241300. MAURANDIA ERUBESCENS (D. Don) A. Gray Scrophulariaceae.

Col. No. 4937. Scrambling perennial; leaves pubescent; flowers tubular rose-pink. (Seeds.)

241301. NEPTUNIA PROSTRATA (Lam.) Baill. Mimosaceae.

Col. No. 4868. Annual; stems spongy white; leaves sensitive to the touch. Grown in shallow water. (Cuttings.)

241302. PELARGONIUM CAYLAE Humbert Geraniaceae.

Col. No. 4869. Perennial to 24 inches high. (Cuttings.)

241303. PELARGONIUM SALMONEUM R. A. Dyer

Col. No. 4860. Leaves green; flowers delicate pink, single. (Cuttings.)

241304. LIGUSTRUM SEMPERVIRENS (Franch.) Lingels. Oleaceae.

Col. No. 4870. Evergreen shrub to 6 inches high, spreading; flowers white, short, tubular, and fragrant. (Cuttings.)
