241388. *MYSTROXYLON AETHIOPICUM* (Thunb.) Loes. Celastraceae.

Col. No. 5009. Evergreen shrub; leaves ovate to nearly orbicular, spine-tipped. Does not flower on the Riviera.

241389. *ELAEAGNUS PLUNGENS* Thunb. Elaeagnaceae. **Thorny elaeagnus.**

Col. No. 5012. Large evergreen shrub; leaves larger than most types.

241390. *GAZANIA × SPLENDENS* Henderson Asteraceae.

Col. No. 5001. 'Alba.' Garden of Villa Roquebrune, Cap Martin. Rhizomatous perennial; flowers white with black eye. (Plant.)

241391. *HIBISCUS SYRIACUS* L. Malvaceae. **Shrub-althea.**

Col. No. 5013. Serre de la Madone, garden of Major Lawrence Johnston, Val du Gorbio, Menton. Shrub; flowers pure white.

241392. *OREOPANAX CAPITATUM* (J. E. Smith) Decne. & Planch. Araliaceae.

Col. No. 4999. Garden of Villa Roquebrune, Cap Martin. Small evergreen tree forming an umbrella specimen; leaves long petiolate, drooping.

241393. *OSMANTHUS* sp. Oleaceae.

Col. No. 5011. Serre de la Madone, Val du Gorbio, garden of Major Lawrence Johnston, Menton. Small evergreen tree; flowers red.

241394. *PELARGONIUM ACETOSA* Soland. Geraniaceae.

Col. No. 5004. Much-branched perennial; woody stems; leaves glaucous, succulent; flowers single, pink, two lower petals striped red.

241396. *PELARGONIUM ZONALE* (L.) L'Her. **Horseshoe geranium**

Col. No. 4998. Succulent perennial; stems triangular; flowers white, striped red at base of corolla lobes inside.

241398. *PELARGONIUM* sp.

Col. No. 5002. Perennial to 2 feet high; flowers single, salmon-pink.

241399. *PHAEDRANTHUS BUCCINATORIUS* (Maire) Miers Bignoniaceae.

Col. No. 5000. Vigorous vine, tendril bearing; flowers burgundy-red.

241400. *PRUNUS CERASIFERA* Ehrh. Amygdalaceae. **Myrobalan plum.**

Col. No. 5008. Foliage dark purple-red.

241401. *SOLANUM RANTONNETII* Carr Solanaceae. **Paraguay nightshade.**

Col. No. 5005. Flowers deep purple.

241402. *TRACHELOSPERMUM JASMINOIDES* Lem. Apocynaceae.

Col. No. 5010. Evergreen subshrub, variegated dwarf form.
