241894. *ACHIMENES COCCINEA* (Scop.) Pers. Gesneriaceae.

Col. No. 5117. Tuberous-rooted perennial; leaves green above, red-veined below; flowers orange-red. (Plants.)

241895. *ARUNDINARIA* sp. Poaceae.

Col. No. 5127. Rhizomatous perennial to 8 feet high; foliage yellowish variegated. (Plant.)

241896. *BOUGAINVILLEA GLABRA* Choisy. Nyctaginaceae.

Col. No. 5126. 'Maud Chettlebourg'. Woody climber; flowers magenta.

241897. *DROSOPHYLLUM LUSITANICUM* (L.) Link. Droseraceae.

Col. No. 5130. Three miles west of Coimbra. Perennial to 12 inches high; leaves tufted, narrowly linear, covered with stalked glutinous glands for catching insects; flowers yellow. (Seeds.)

241898. *ERICA AUSTRALIS* L. Ericaceae.

Heath.

Col. No. 5131. Along the Rio Mondego, east of Coimbra. Evergreen shrub to 6 feet high; flowers lavender to pink.

241899. *ERICA UMBELLATA* L.

Heath.

Col. No. 5133. West of Coimbra. Evergreen shrub to 20 inches high; flowers lavender-purple. (Seeds.)

241900. *FICUS GLABELLA* Blume. Moraceae.

Col. No. 5128. Evergreen tree to 20 feet high; leaves long, coriaceous, lustrous.

241901. *GNIDIA POLYSTACHYA* Berg. Thymelaeaceae.

Col. No. 5128. Evergreen shrub to 10 feet high; leaves acicular; flowers yellow-green, fragrant.

241902. *HEBANTHE PANICULATA* (Moq.) Benth. & Hook. Amaranthaceae.

Col. No. 5123. Evergreen climber; flowers white.

241903. *HIBISCUS LILIFLORUS* Cav. Malvaceae.

Col. No. 5121. Shrub to 6 feet high; flowers scarlet, single.

241904 and 241905. *HIBISCUS ROSA-SINENSIS* L.

Chinese hibiscus.

241904. Col. No. 5122. 'Vivicans'. Shrub; flowers double, scarlet.

241905. Col. No. 5125. 'Kermesinus'. Shrub to 10 feet high; flowers single, deep red.

241906. *IOCHROMA COCCINEA* Scheid. Solanaceae.

Col. No. 5119. Branches pendulous; flowers tubular, scarlet.

241907. *IOCHROMA WARSCEWICZII* Regel

Col. No. 5124. Shrub; leaves long, pubescent; flowers tubular, blue.

241908. *JASMINUM ODORATISSIMUM* L. Oleaceae.

Col. No. 5118. Evergreen shrub; branches somewhat arching; flowers yellow, fragrant.
