242030. ANTIRRHINUM GLUTINOSUM Boiss. & Reut. Scrophulariaceae.

Col. No. 5070. North of Granada on the road to Jaen, Province of Granada. Perennial, much-branched from the base; flowers yellowish-white.

242031. CALLITRIS CUPRESSIFORMIS Vent. Pinaceae.

Col. No. 5116. Park da Pena, near Sintra, west of Lisbon, Portugal

242032 to 242034. Along Granada-Vasares de Veleta road, Sierra Nevada Mountains.**242032. CHADNORRHINUM CRASSIFOLIUM var. GLARESOUM Boiss. Scrophulariaceae.**

Col. No. 5068. Densely tufted rhizomatous perennial, forming small mats; flowers bluish-purple, throat reddish.

242033. DAPHNE GINDIUM L. Thymelaeaceae.

Col. No. 5076. Evergreen shrub, much-branched from the base; flowers at the ends of the branches, creamy-white and fragrant; fruit fleshy, orange-red.

242034. DAPHNE OLEOIDES Schreb.

Olive daphne.

Col. No. 5072. Much-branched evergreen shrub to 4 feet high; flowers white to purplish; fruit red.

242035. DIANTHUS BRACHYANTHUS Boiss. Silenaceae.

Col. No. 5063. Behind the Penones de San Francisco (Hotel), Granada-Vasares de Veleta road to Sierra Nevada Mountains. Densely tufted perennial; flowers rose.

242036. DIGITALIS OBSCURA L. Scrophulariaceae.

Col. No. 5075. Along road from Granada to Vasares de Veleta, Sierra Nevada Mountains. Much-branched shrub; flowers reddish yellow; leaves willowlike.

242037. ERINACEA PUNGENS Boiss. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 5059. Along road to the Summit of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Densely tufted cushion plant; branches naked and spine-tipped, yellowish-green; flowers blue.

242038. LYCIUM AFRUM L. Solanaceae.

Col. No. 5106. Botanical Garden, University of Lisbon, Portugal. Large much-branched shrub; fruits orange.

242039. MARRUBIUM SUPINUM L. Menthaceae.

Col. No. 5058. Behind the Penones de San Francisco, Sierra Nevada Mountains. Rhizomatous perennial; flowers lavender.

242040. PHLOMIS HERBA-VENTI L. Menthaceae.

Col. No. 5071. Along stream bank north of Granada on road to Jaen. Perennial; leaves lustrous green above; flowers lavender to violet.

242041. RHAMNUS OLEOIDES L. Rhamnaceae.

Col. No. 5073. Along the Granada-Vasares de Veleta road to the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Fruits red, turning black.

242042 and 242043. Botanical Garden, University of Lisbon, Portugal.**242042. QUILLAJA BRASILIENSIS (St. Hil. & Tul.) Mart. Rosaceae.**

Col. No. 5101. Tree to 30 feet high; flowers white and fragrant.
