Col. No. 5244. 'Ferox Aurea'. Staminate plant; leaves ovate, strongly coarse spine-toothed, undulate-margined, margins recurved, upper surface of the leaf, spiny towards the tip.

242188. ILEX $\times$ ALTAFLARENSIS Dallim.

Col. No. 5240. 'Donningtonensis'. Leaves irregularly coarse toothed, tip often recurved. (Staminate)

242189. Col. No. 5246. 'Latispina'. Staminate plant; leaves irregularly shaped, sometimes oblique at the tip, margins variously undulate, spiny.

242190. Col. No. 5242. 'Scotica'. Twigs purplish; leaves faintly undulate-margined, entire, tip obtuse or spiny, thick. (Staminate)

242191. Col. No. 5250. (Unnamed cultivar). Leaves coarsely spine-toothed, with a narrow yellowish-green margin.

242192. ILEX FRANCHETIANA Loes.

Col. No. 5251. Large evergreen shrub; leaves elliptic to oblanceolate. Grown under Wilson 148.

242193. ILEX FRANCHETIANA Loes.

Col. No. 5248. Leaves evergreen, elliptic, finely serrate, tip acuminate.

242194. ILEX $\times$ ALTAFLARENSIS Dallim.

Col. No. 5245. Leaves strongly and coarsely spine-toothed, undulate.

242195. EUPHORBIA LANCIFOLIA Schlecht. Euphorbiaceae.
