242407. *PHOTINIA INTEGRIFOLIA* Lindl. Malaceae.

Col. No. 5435. Evergreen shrub; leaves elliptic to oblanceolate, acuminate, lustrous green above.

242408. *PIPTANTHUS LABURNIFOLIUS* (D. Don) Stapf Fabaceae.

Col. No. 5434. Evergreen shrub to 15 feet high; leaves trifoliate, deep green.

242409. *PLEIOSTACHYA* sp. Marantaceae.

Col. No. 5441. Rhizomatous perennial to 5 feet high; culms hairy; leaves reddish. (Plant.)

242410. *RESTIO SUBVERTICILLATUS* Masters Restionaceae.

Col. No. 5444. Stout rhizomatous perennial, forming dense clumps; culms to 6 feet high, bright green with reddish papery bracts at the nodes; inflorescence wandlike. (Plant.)

242411. *RHODODENDRON CRASSUM* Franch. Ericaceae.

Col. No. 5432. Evergreen shrub to 10 feet high; leaves to 5 inches long, rusty tomentose and lustrous green above, dull below; flowers white.

242412. *SALIX MOUPINENSIS* Franch. Salicaceae.

Col. No. 5438. Shrub; leaves elliptic, serrate, shiny green above, dull below; buds red, shiny.

242413. *SARGENTODXA CUNEATA* (Oliver) Rehd. & Wils. Lardizabalaceae.

Col. No. 5421. Woody vine to 25 feet long; leaves trifoliate; flowers unisexual bell shaped, greenish yellow.

242414. *SAURAUJA NAPAULENSIS* DC. Dilleniaceae.

Col. No. 5431. Tree to 20 feet high; much-branched; leaves oblanceolate or elliptic, serrate; flowers pink with a red eye.

242415. *SCROPHULARIA NODOSA* L. Scrophulariaceae.

Col. No. 5422. 'Variegata'. Perennial to 3 feet high; leaves ovate, serrate-dentate, with white margins.

242416. *TAPEINOCHEILOS PUNGENS* (Teysm. & Binn.) Miquel Zingiberaceae.

Col. No. 5400. Rhizomatous perennial to 5 feet high; leaves broadly elliptic; inflorescence basal, conelike with reddish, waxlike bracts. (Plants.)

242417. *TRIPTYRYGIUM FORRESTII* Loesn. Celastraceae.

Col. No. 5430. Much-branched shrub from the base; leaves ovate, serrate, long acuminate.

242418 and 242419. *CARTHAMUS TINCTORIUS* L. Asteraceae.**Safflower.**
