242517. AGAPANTHUS ORIENTALIS Leighton Liliaceae.

Col. No. 5605. 'Trudy'. Flowers very dark blue, semi-pendulous.

242518 to 242525. BUXUS SEMPERVIRENS L. Buxaceae. Common box.

242518. Col. No. 5592. 'Aurea-Pendula'. Weeping boxwood; branches pendulous; leaves ovate to 1.25 inch long, deep green, yellowish variegated. (Cuttings.)

242519. Col. No. 5582. 'Rotundifolia'. Erect form; leaves to 1 inch long.

242520. Col. No. 5594. 'Rotundifolia Maculata'. Leaves mostly ovate to nearly round, some streaked with yellow.

242521. Col. No. 5591. 'Bullata'. Leaves broadly ovate to suborbicular, 1.25 inch long, deep green.

242522. Col. No. 5590. 'Myosotifolia'. Leaves elliptic, to 1.25 inch long.

242523. Col. No. 5593. 'Pendula'. Branches pendulous; leaves 0.75 inch long, mostly elliptic.

242524. Col. No. 5595. 'Prostrata'. Stiff-growing prostrate boxwood to 2 feet high; branches white, showing through the very dark green lustrous foliage.

242525. Col. No. 5598. 'Angustifolia'. Leaves to 1 inch long, mostly ovate, upper surface sometimes semirugose, dark green.

242526. CORNUS ALTERNIFOLIA L. f. Cornaceae.

Col. No. 5584. 'Argentea'. Shrub to 6 feet high; leaves streaked with white. (Cuttings.)

242527. CYNORCHIS UNCINATA H. Perr. Orchidaceae.

Col. No. 5616. Terrestrial.
