Col. No. 5512. 'Double Rose-Flowered'. Flowers roselike in appearance, dark-red.

242612. PEPEROMIA BRACHYTRICHA Baker Piperaceae.

Col. No. 5519. Creeping epiphyte to 6 inches high, rooting at the nodes; leaves obovate, succulent, to 1 inch in diameter.

242613. PEPEROMIA MADAGASCARIENSIS DC.

Col. No. 5525. Creeping epiphyte, rooting at the nodes; leaves fleshy, uniformly puberulent, green above, purplish-red below.

242614. PEPEROMIA ROTUNDIFOLIA Schlecht. & Cham.

Col. No. 5520. Creeping epiphyte, rooting at the nodes; leaves to 1 inch long.

242615. RUELLIA MACRANTHA Mart. Acanthaceae.

Col. No. 5526. Perennial to 6 feet high; leaves green above, covered by raphides below; flowers fuchsia-pink.

242616. BURBIDGEA SCHIZOCHEILA W. Hackett Zingiberaceae.

Col. No. 5532. Rhizomatous perennial; leaves dark green, lustrous.

Col. No. 5169. Arboretum, Vilmorin-Andrieux et Cie, Verrieres-le-Buisson, southwest Paris, France.

242629. SAROTHAMNUS WELWITSCHII Bois & Reut. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 5161. Open dry rocky granite slopes, Guarda. Much-branched shrub to 8 feet high; flowers yellow, pods villous.
