243892. *MACLEANEA PUNCTATA* Hook. f. Vacciniaceae.

Col. No. 6126. Scrambling evergreen shrub on rocks; lustrous green above; flowers agapetes-like.

243893. *TRIPOGANDRA GRANDIFLORA* (Donn. Smith) R. E. Woodson Commelinaceae.

Col. No. 6117. Sprawling perennial; stems wiry; leaves lustrous green; flowers whitish.

Col. No. 6124. *P. coerulea-racemosa* $\times$ *P. quadrangularis*. Flowers white shaded pink; corona white and dark purple.
