244703. G. 2629. 'Verde 610 Moganga'. Fruits cylindric, green.

244704. G. 2630. 'Ovo de Ganzo 619 Moganga'. Fruits the size of small 'Table Queen'; buff. Quality good.

244705 to 244707. *CUCURBITA MOSCHATA* Duchesne **Cushaw.**

244705. G-2631. 'Menina Amarela 724'. Fruits large, crookneck, buff.

244706. G-2632. 'Paca 595'. Fruits large, oval, green mottled with orange.

244707. G-2633. 'Tatur'. Fruits oval; buff.

244708. *ALLIUM CEPA* L. Liliaceae. **Common onion.**

G-2227. 'Owen Button'. From Fulton, N.Y., called 'Mother's Button' around Fulton.

244709. *ALLIUM PORRUM* L. **Leek.**

G-2483. 'Italian Leek'. Grown by Italian-Americans near Painted Post, N.Y.

244710 to 244712. *ALLIUM SATIVUM* L. **Garlic.**

244710. G-6100. 'Egyptain Garlic'. From Seabrook, N.H.

244711. G-6563. 'Perennial Garlic'. From Fort Worth, Texas.

244712. G-6564. 'Oriental Garlic'. From a California seed firm.

244713. *CUCUMIS MELO* L. Cucurbitaceae. **Muskmelon**

G-6611. 'Mango Melon Chito'. Found in a seed packet of 'Surecrop' from Hart Seed Co., Wethersfield, Conn. Flesh firm, sweet.

244714. *CUCUMIS MELO* var. *INODORUS* Naudin

G-5619. 'Turkish Honeydew'. From Turkey. Fruits 8 by 7 inches diameter; rind orange and green; flesh orange and white. Free from wilt and mosaic.

244715. *PHASEOLUS VULGARIS* L. Fabaceae. **Common bean.**

G-2272. 'Black Mexican'. From Cornwall, England, but originally from Mexico. Bush to half runner type.

244716. *SOLANUM MELONGENA* L. Solanaceae. **Eggplant.**

G-2629. A nearly prostrate form introduced from Turkey with seeds of *Capsicum frutescens* in 1949. Fruits oblong ovate, to 6 inches long, purple turning dull brown.
