Maple.

Originally from the Rochester Parks, N.Y. Tree small; bark striped.

245025. *ACER CARPINIFOLIUM* Sieb. & Zucc.

Hornbeam maple.

Originally from Yamagata-gun, Hiroshima Prefecture, Japan. 1953.

245026. *BUXUS SEMPERVIRENS* L. **Buxaceae.**

Common box.

'Agram'. Chance seedlings from seed collected near Skoplje in the Vardas River Valley, Yugoslavia; originally from the United States. A fastigiate form.

245027. *CARPINUS TURCZANINOVII* Hance **Betulaceae.**

Hornbeam.

From the Kornik Arboretum, Kornik, Poland. Tree symmetrical, deciduous; excellent autumn coloration.

245028. *CORNUS MAS* L. **Cornaceae.**

Cornelian-cherry

Near Ankara, Turkey, 1953.

245029. *CORNUS URBINIANA* Rose

Dogwood.

Original seeds collected near the border of Tamaulipas and Nueva Leon, Mexico, 1948. Elevation 4,500 ft. Tree or shrub, wild specimens to 50 ft. high; leaves ovate-elliptic to 6 inches long, acuminate, glabrate above, pale beneath and sericeous-strigillose; flower heads pedunculate, bracts white and petallike, oblong or narrowly obovate to 2 inches long; fruit red.
