245316. Col. No. C. 7. 'Papa Cirila'. Drought resistant; tubers pinkish-purple; flesh white.

245317. Col. No. C. 8. 'Papa Blanca de Cauquenes'. Tubers white; eyes shallow; flesh white.

245318. Col. No. C. 9. 'Papa Reina Redonda'. Drought resistant; tubers deep pink; eyes rather shallow.
