

246459. *SCHINUS MOLLE* L. Anacardiaceae. **California peppertree.**

Col. No. 18041. 'Aroeira'. Tree small; twigs and foliage pendent; leaves light green.

246460. *BOUGAINVILLEA SPECTABILIS* Willd. Nyctaginaceae. **Great bougainvillea.**

Col. No. 18016. Small tree or tall shrub becoming scandent with age; flowers white.

246461. *MALUS SYLVESTRIS* Mill. Malaceae. **Common apple.**

'Red Cox's Pomona'. A dual purpose midwinter variety, popular in colder districts.

246462. *PYRUS COMMUNIS* L. Malaceae. **Common pear.**

'Red colored de Juillet'. From a 15-year-old tree.

246463 and 246464. *MALUS SYLVESTRIS* Mill. Malaceae. **Common apple.**

246463. 'James Grieve'. Neumanns Rotar strain of German origin.

246464. 'James Grieve'. Red Rosamund strain of English origin.

246465 to 246475.

From Brazil. Seeds collected by Llewelyn Williams, agricultural explorer, New Crops Research Branch, Crops Research Division, Beltsville, Md. Received March 11, 1958.

246465. *CAMOENSIA MAXIMA* Welw. Fabaceae.

Col. No. 18025. Woody vine; foliage dark green; flowers white. Native to tropical Africa.

246466. *CORDIA SUPERBA* Cham. Boraginaceae.

Col. No. 18083. Tree to 20 feet high; fruit contains a white, sticky, edible pulp. Native of Brazil.

246467. *DIOSPYROS APEIBACARPOS* Raddi Diospyraceae.

Col. No. 18056. Tree to 15 feet high; fruits edible; pulp yellow.

246468. *EUGENIA JAMBOS* L. Myrtaceae. **Rose-apple.**

Col. No. 18019. 'Jambo Rosa'. Tree to 12 feet high; fruits striped pinkish; pulp edible.

246469. *EUGENIA MALACCENSIS* L. **Ohia.**

Col. No. 18018. 'Jambo Vermelho'. Tree to 18 feet high; fruit has edible pulp.

246470. *HEVEA BRASILIENSIS* (A. Juss.) Muell.-Arg. Euphorbiaceae. **Para rubber tree.**

Col. No. 18066. 'Sirlinga Borracha'. Tree to 90 feet high.

246471. *JACARATIA DODECAPHYLLA* DC. Caricaceae.

Col. No. 18010. 'Jaccaratia'. Small tree in sandy soil; fruits edible.

246472. *NYMPHAEA* sp. Nymphaeaceae.

Col. No. 18064. Aquatic plant; flowers deep purple.

246473. *NICOLAIA ELATIOR* (Jack) Horan. Zingiberaceae.

Col. No. 18063. 'Bastao do Imperador'. Stems to 12 feet high with flowering stems to 3 feet high.

246474. *PHILODENDRON SPECIOSUM* Schott. Araceae.

Col. No. 18094. Straggly plant to 3 feet high; stems often crawling along ground; leaves dark green.
