

246573. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-283. Below Canta, Lima. Elevation 2,475 meters. Plant robust; flowers purple, rotate.

246574. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-285. Slopes above Canta, Lima. Elevation 2,850 meters. Flowers large, purple, rotate.

246575. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-288. Above Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,200 meters. Plants robust; flowers large, rotate, purple. Rust present.

246576. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-289. Along road above Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,300 meters. Plants stout; flowers purplish.

246577. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-291. Above Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,400 meters. Plants unusually hispid; tubers globular-ellipsoid.

246578. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-292. Above Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,400 meters. Plants low, glabrous; leaves deep green on upper surface.

246579. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-293. Ubiquitous along road below Culluay, on road to Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,500 meters. Plant abundant, tall and showy with many long-peduncled flowers.

246580. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. 294. Forms a small colony below Culluay, road to Canta, Lima. Plants tall, bushy; flowers pale lavender, almost white; tubers large, flattish.

246581. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-295. Below Culluay, road to Canta, Lima. Elevation 3,600 meters. Plants robust, stems and rachis purplish; flowers deep purple, to 4.5 cm. in diameter, rotate-stellate; tubers very irregular.

246582. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-296. Near Culluay. Elevation 3,800 meters. Plants bushy, to 1.5 decimeters high and wide; flowers large, deep purple, rotate; tubers with purplish skin and flesh.

246583. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-297. Rocky slopes near Culluay. Elevation 3,900 meters. Plant low, rosette-like to tall, depending on exposure; flowers purple; tubers orbicular.

246584. SOLANUM sp.

Col. No. P-290. Rocky slope above Canta. Elevation 3,300 meters. Plants stiffly erect, glabrous throughout; leaves verrucose above; flowers pure white, rotate-stellate.

246585. LYCOPERSICON (hybrid). Solanaceae.

Col. No. P-147. ((*L. peruvianum* × *L. glandulosum*) × *L. hirsutum*). West of Andes, Nasca-Puquio Road, Peru. El. 2,100 meters. Flowers yellow with yellowish-green fruits.

246586. LYCOPERSICON PERUVIANUM (L.) Mill.

Col. No. P-174. Near Atico. Plants bushy, brittle; flowers yellow, stellate.
