

248609. Col. No. 16936. Between Gata and Alicante. Younger more vigorous plant with larger leaves than the others; pods to 7 inches long.
248610. Col. No. 16937. Between Gata and Alicante. Well-pruned, early-maturing tree with heavy crop of large, rather uniform pods.
248611. Col. No. 16947. 'Algarrobo'. Near Elche, Alicante Province. Mature tree; flowers perfect; pods uniformly long and rather slender, maturing early.
248612. Col. No. 16948. Elche, Alicante Province. Young tree of open type foliage; flowers perfect; pods uniformly long and straight, maturing early.

248613. Col. No. 16962. Near Guadix, Granada Province. Elevation 2,500 feet. Tufted, drought resistant, winter-spring perennial, forage grass, seeding freely in summer.
