

249409. TIBOUCHINA sp.

Col. No. 18790. Campinas Grande do Sul, Serra do Mar, Parana. Herb or subshrub to 18 inches high; stems and fruit covered with light brown pubescens; flowers purplish.

249410. TIBOUCHINA sp.

Col. No. 18918. Riberao do Rancho, Corupa, Santa Catharina. Elevation 1,900 feet. Straggly shrub to 6 feet high.

249411. TIBOUCHINA sp.

Col. No. 18919. 'Tinhorao'. Riberao do Rancho, Corupa, Santa Catharina. Elevation 2,200 feet. Tree to 20 feet high; flowers lilac.

249412. TIBOUCHINA sp.

Col. No. 18931. Riberao do Rancho, Santa Catharina. Tree to 12 feet high; flowers dark red.

249413. VITEX MONTEVIDENSIS Cham. Verbenaceae.

Col. No. 18555. 'Tarumao'. Alto da Serra, Paranapiacaba, Sao Paulo. Tree to 15 feet high; crown flat; fruits dark purplish.

249414. MOMORDICA CHARANTIA L. Cucurbitaceae.**Balsam-pear.**

Col. No. 18139. Botanical Garden, Rio de Janeiro. Climber; flowers yellow; fruits large, deep-yellow.

249415. (Undetermined.)

Col. No. 18554. Alta da Serra, Paranapiacaba, Sao Paulo. Small shrub; crown dense; leaves small, dark green; fruits small, pinkish-red when ripe.

249416. (Undetermined.)

Col. No. 18590. Fazenda da Bonita, Serra da Bocaina, Sao Paulo. Elevation 3,700 feet. Shrub; flowers purplish to pink.

Col. No. 18784. Aracatuba, Serra do Mar, Parana. Elevation 2,800 feet. Shrub to 30 inches high; fruits dark, almost black.

Col. No. 18819. 'Tomate do Japao'. Cuatro Barras, Serra do Mar, Parana. Elevation 2,800 feet. Wide-spreading bush to 8 feet high; fruits ovoid, deep pink, edible; seeds small, flat.
